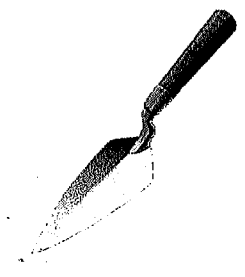


Digging up the Facts
